Notes

- 1 The trial program is intended for new members exclusively.
Fees paid for the trial program are transferable to the Sail all Summer program at any time in the season.
- 2 New members who discover the Centre late in the season can register to the Sail all Summer program as of August 1st for the amount of \$450. The annual membership fee of \$25 is collected separately.
- 3 Discounts are based on the date of registration. If registered in person, the date submitted is used.
For registration by mail, the post mark date is considered the official registration date.
- 4 Members registered for Sail all Summer can pay in either one or two payments. Postdated cheque or credit card are accepted.
If they decide on two (2) payments:
 - a) the initial payment of 50% is payable at the time of registration plus the annual membership fee of \$25
 - b) the balance is payable by April 30th.
- 5 The Centre will reimburse a member who withdraws from the Sail all Summer Program prior to the start of the season as indicated on the schedule published on the web site, less administrative charges of \$25.
- 6 The Centre is not responsible for outings or on-water training sessions that are cancelled due to bad weather conditions, boat repairs or unavailability of skippers. Accordingly, there will be no refunds, transfers or credits to members or guests for cancelled outings or training.
- 7 Please present a copy of birth certificate for youth aged 12-17 years of age at the time of registration (proof of age as at June 1st).
- 8 "Borealis 101" is now mandatory for all new members. It includes fundamentals of sailing, security and directives to be respected on the Centre's sail boats.
- 9 The Basic Cruising Course from Sail Canada consists of:

- Basic Cruising Skills by Gillian West (the publication)	\$ 40
- Log Book	\$ 20
- Aids to Navigation	Free
- On the water training, On-water and Theoretical Tests, plus seal	\$ 20

NB: You must be registered for the Sail all Summer program for this course. You are also required to have access to a copy of Gillian West while you are taking the course; if you are able to borrow or readily share a copy with another course participant you are not required to purchase the publication.

- Contact the skipper or send an email to info@VoileBorealis.org to obtain more information. Other cruises may be added during the season. Please note that crew members must be BSC members to participate in a Live Aboard Sail Cruise. Priority will be given to members registered to "Sail all Summer" program.
- The rate indicated:
 - reflects a preliminary estimate of the costs to charter a sail boat. Common fees will be split later (See **Note 4**)
 - is based on the number of crew noted for the cruise
 - will be adjusted when the skipper has more information, such as the dates, the type of sail boat.
 - includes a \$50 contribution per crew member towards a reserve for damages to rented sail boats.
- Crew members for LASC may pay in three installments (post-dated cheque or credit card payments):
 - the first installment of \$ 250 is payable at the time of registration;
 - the second installment of \$ 250 is payable on January 31, and;
 - the balance is payable on March 31.
- Crew members are responsible for their travel expenses, and in addition to boat rental costs, they share equally among themselves charter operating expenses. The later include the sleep aboard on the night previous to sailing, insurance deductible reduction, food in common, overnight docking costs, fuel, moorings and pump-outs.
- If the viability conditions of the Live Aboard Sail Cruise are not met, the cruise will be cancelled and the Centre will reimburse the Sail Cruise payments to the crew members in the ten (10) days following the decision.
- When a member is unable to participate in the LASC for which he/she has registered, the member may be reimbursed the payment(s) made for the LASC if the BSC receives notification before the first deposit is paid to the charterer. If the BSC receives notification of unavailability after the 1st deposit to the charterer, the crew member must notify the skipper of the situation and commit to finding a replacement. The replacement must fulfill all the requirements for membership and pay the BSC, who will reimburse the member withdrawing, less administrative charges of \$25. In the event where no replacement can be found, no reimbursement will be made to the member who has withdrawn, and the member will be responsible for the entire amount of his share of the boat rental for the LASC.
- Each request for reimbursement must be presented to the Board of Directors for approval. The Centre will enforce this policy rigorously.
